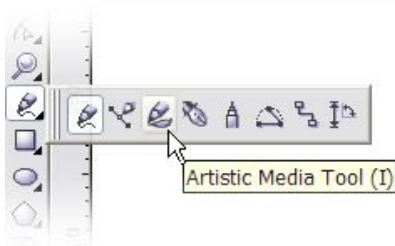


Converting lines into Power Embroidery

CorelDRAW lets you spray a series of objects in a line. This feature makes a perfect embroidered perimeter for applique but also gives a creative look in design decoration.



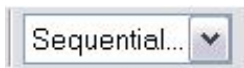
1. Open the **Curve** flyout, and click the **Artistic media** tool.



2. On the property bar, click the **Sprayer** button .



3. From the **Spraylist** file list, choose **funguys**.



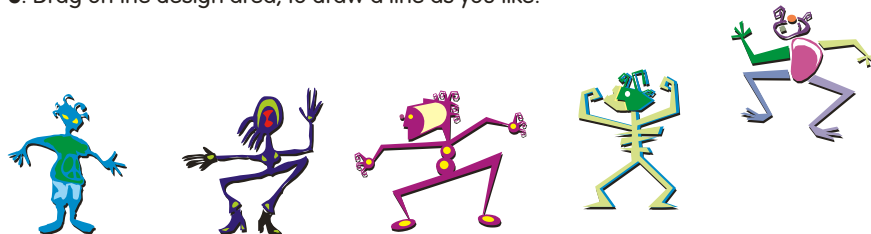
5. From the **Choice of spray order** list box, choose **Sequential**.



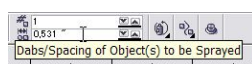
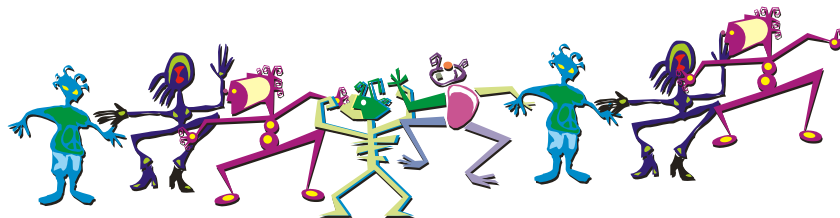
4. In the **Size of object(s) to be sprayed** box, type **40**.



6. Drag on the design area, to draw a line as you like.



7. Release the mouse and voila.....
This is what the drawing should look like:



8. Type a number in the bottom box of the **Dabs/Spacing of Objects to be Sprayed** box on the property bar.
This adjusts the spacing between the dabs.
