
## **Converting lines into Power Embroidery**

CorelDRAW lets you spray a series of objects in a line. This feature makes a perfect embroidered perimeter for applique but also gives a creative look in design decoration.



1. Open the **Curve** flyout, and click the **Artistic media** tool.



**2.** On the property bar, click the **Sprayer** button .




**3.** From the **Spraylist file** list, choose **funguys.** 



**5.** From the **Choice of spray order** list box, choose **Sequential.** 



4. In the Size of object(s) to be sprayed box, type 40.




6. Drag on the design area, to draw a line as you like.



**7.** Release the mouse and voila.....
This is what the drawing should look like:





8. Type a number in the bottom box of the Dabs/Spacing of Objects to be Sprayed box on the property bar. This adjusts the spacing between the dabs.
